An Insider's Story: How Collaboration Between the American and Israeli Intelligence Agencies Disrupted the Iranian Nuclear Program

Thursday, October 30 | 11:30 AM Lunch | 12 PM Program Begins | In-Person and Zoom To prepare for an expected conflict burdened 21st Century, the United States undertook an ambitious campaign to modernize its Intelligence Agencies and Black Ops project targets throughout the 1990's.

Join us as Mike Nicholson, Maia Surace's husband, walks us through 30 years of his personal experiences within these areas. From the accidental discovery of what became the backbone of the United States' 21st century stealth technology, to how the attacks on September 11th came within a whisper of rendering that same technology extinct.

He will lead us through his journey of being mistakenly arrested, to being recruited by the CIA, and from parachuting into a war zone to gather intelligence, to working with Israeli Intelligence analyzing data and planning for the attacks on Register Here: Iranian nuclear facilities during Operation Midnight Hammer.
